Village Park. The Village was interested in implementing the project as a Community Build effort involving as many individuals and organizations as possible, and including local contractors who had volunteered their services. To accommodate the Community Build vision, J&A developed demolition plans to be utilized by the volunteer contractors to prepare the site for the proposed playscape. J&A also provided consulting services to the contractors and Village representatives during implementation of the demolition phase of the project.

A Bid Package was developed for the playscape Bidders to provide a park design and to identify the related playscape equipment that would meet both the project budget, as well as specific functional criteria established by the Village. The selected playscape Contractor provided the personnel to coordinate and supervise a Community Build team for the playscape construction. The improvements to the park included revised drainage, select tree removal, and installation of playscape equipment. The playscape design included a cushioned wood surface to provide for fall protection and handicap access. The project was funded in part by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, Clean Michigan Initiative Recreation Bond Program. J&A also assisted the Village in grant administration for this project.
