### **Innovative and Cost Effective Charter Township of Waterford Water Main Lining Project Wins Prestigious Award**

J&A is pleased to announce the Charter Township of Waterford Drinking Water Revolving Fund Water Main Lining Project has recently been awarded Project of the Year in the category of *Environment Less Than \$5 Million*, by the Michigan Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA).

The Township was the first community in the State of Michigan and the United States to receive a permit to utilize a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) liner to rehabilitate municipal potable water main. Waterford Township Department of Public Works, along with Johnson & Anderson as the engineer and LiquiForce as the contractor, developed, designed, and constructed a multi segment water main rehabilitation project using CIPP to structurally reline existing water main in the Township.

The award will be presented to the Township at the APWA Annual Conference in May.

J&A is very proud to have been involved on this revolutionary project and we congratulate the Charter Township of Waterford for their vision and commitment to optimized capital improvement planning.
