OAKLAND UNIVERSITY PIONEER DRIVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

In May of 2007, J&A, under its preferred vendor registration with Oakland University, compiled plans, specifications and bid documents for the rehabilitation of the asphalt pavement and curbing on

Pioneer Drive. This section of Pioneer Drive is the main north-south arterial on the east side of the University and could only be closed for short periods of time. Under extremely tight deadlines, J&A was able to secure bids and perform full time inspection and contract administration for the pavement replacement that allowed Pioneer Drive to open to traffic prior to the advent of the fall semester at Oakland University.

The project was closed out in September, 2007. The cost of the completed work came in under budget allowing the remaining resources to be used for pavement repairs at various locations on campus.



Completed and Open to Traffic

One of the key concerns during construction was the accommodation of pedestrians thru the construction site. Temporary bypass walk routes were established using barricades and construction fencing. Safety of the traffic and pedestrians during construction was rigorously enforced.
