Township to: prepare the Township's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit applications for Storm Water Discharges from Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems; develop Storm Water Management Plans (SWMPs) and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPs), Pollution Incident Prevention Plans (PIPPs), and Illicit Discharge Elimination Plans (IDEPs).
